Feeding Our Love of Literacy

We are so fortunate to have so many community partners to support our students and families. Today, Love Child Organics sponsored an author visit for many of our classes. Brandee Buble read her books *O'Shae the Octopus* and *Jayde The Jaybird* to our students and talked about being an author.

Brandee is famous at our school as she is a former Educational Assistant who worked at Maywood for many years. She has inspired us to be writers and to find what makes us unique and special. Love Child Organics and First Book Canada believe in supporting family literacy and provided 4000 brand new books for our students to take home including copies of Brandee's books. Your child will be bringing home some books this week. Please take some time to read with your child and enjoy their new books.



Next week, our students will be developing their physical literacy with soccer coaches from PASS Soccer (Play Active School Soccer). This is a free program where local soccer leaders teach our students basic soccer skills as well as the importance of balance, agility and focus.



In mid October, our students will be learning a hip hop routine with dance instructors from VIBE. It's so exciting to see our students develop their love of dance, movement and musical literacy with such wonderful teachers. We are fortunate to be able to provide this experience at no cost to parents this year as we have received a grant to support student learning.

Step 3: You will receive a confirmation email. Select the "click here" option, sign in and add your child(ren) to your household account. Make sure the check the box that asks if you want to receive the email notifications. You will then receive notifications each time a school fee is available to pay for your child(ren).

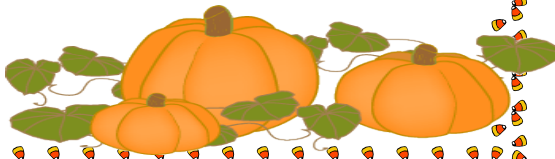

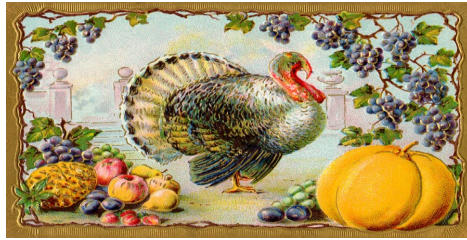
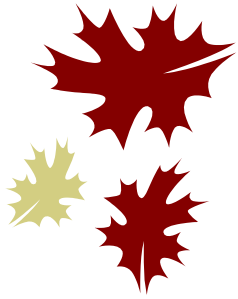
