

## *Principal's Message:* Our School Goal

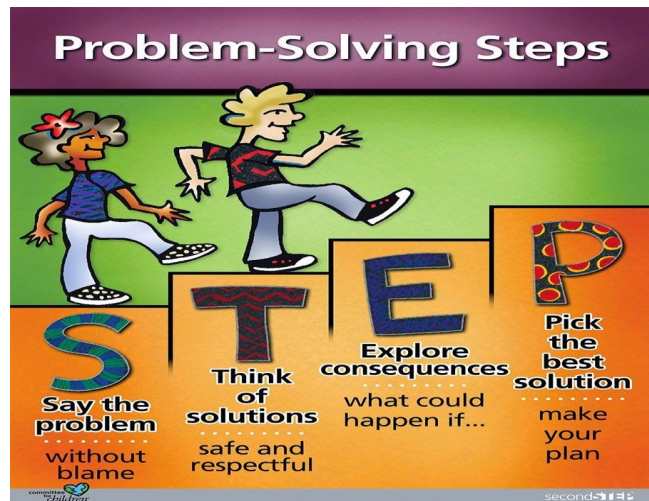

In the next two months, your children will be learning to identify the size of their problems so they can figure out if they can solve it themselves or if they need help. They will also learn some common language for solving problems.

## We will take these STEPS:

1. Say the problem without blame
2. Think about safe and respectful solutions.
3. Explore consequences and think about what could happen if...
4. Pick the best solution and make a plan.

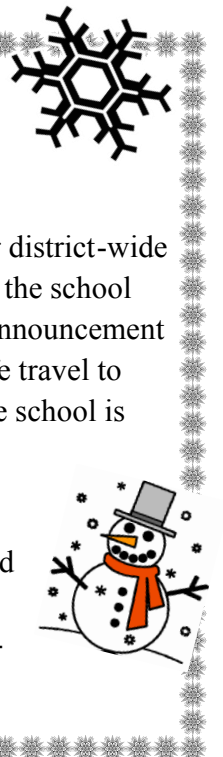
