If a student is ill with any common cold, influenza or COVID-19 like symptoms, they must stay home and either isolate for 10 calendar days following onset of symptoms, or until symptoms resolve. Contact 8-1-1 for guidance if you are unsure of the symptoms or access the online COVID-19 Assessment Tool at https://bc.thrive.health/covid19/en. If returning before 10 days, provide a medical note.

^{**} If a child is presenting baseline symptoms such as seasonal allergies please contact administration for further guidance.

^{***} Students may still attend school if a member of their household has cold, influenza, or COVID-19-like symptoms, provided the students is asymptomatic and is cleared by a health care provider.
