Personal and Cultural Identity—We develop this core competency when we:

- share who we are, our families and our culture
- make choices that fit with our beliefs
- identify our own strengths and goals

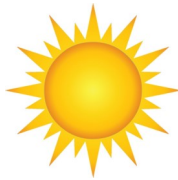
Personal Awareness and Responsibility—We develop this core competency when we:

- make good choices to be health and safe

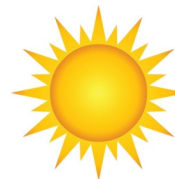
Social Responsibility—We develop this core competency when we:

Between the 2 learning groups, they picked up 7 bags of trash over the space of 2 hours. A lot of the trash were discarded coffee cups and masks. This is a good reminder to people everywhere to put their trash in a garbage bins and not to litter.

Leadership students also worked on a survey on how much trash they produced each week at home and then figured how much trash they produced for the year. The results are staggering!!! For one year **8983 plastic bags** were used. The survey was only a small number of students in Maywood, so you can imagine if we totaled up the entire school use of plastic bags how much it would be.
