Principal's Message: Core Competency Self Assessments

Throughout the year, our students have been developing their core competencies. The core competencies are sets of intellectual, personal and social-emotional proficiencies that all students need in order to engage in deep, lifelong learning. Communication—We develop this core competency when we:

- connect and engage with others
- find and present information
- collaborate with others
- Explain, tell or reflect on our experiences

Thinking—We develop this core competency when we:

- play and explore
- pursue ideas that we are interested in and passionate about
- develop and expand our ideas in new ways
- analyze and critique ideas and information
- question and investigate
- develop and design

Personal and Cultural Identity—We develop this core competency when we:

- share who we are, our families and our culture
- make choices that fit with our beliefs
- identify our own strengths and goals

Personal Awareness and Responsibility—We develop this core competency when we:

- show pride in our accomplishments and advocate for ourselves
- regulate our emotions and behavior
- make good choices to be health and safe

Social Responsibility—We develop this core competency when we:

- Contribute to our community and care for the environment
- Solve problems in peaceful ways
- Value diversity
- Build relationship to work and play with others

Core Competency Self-Assessments: Your child is taking time to assess their development in these core competencies. They are identifying their strengths and setting goals for themselves. By the end of the school year, your child will share their core competency reflections and learning. Please take time to talk with them and celebrate their strengths. You can also support them with their goal for improvement over the summer.





On Monday April 19, Maywood leadership went and picked up trash between Metrotown and Maywood along the sky train corridor. Between the 2 learning groups, they picked up 7 bags of trash over the space of 2 hours. A lot of the trash were discarded coffee cups and masks. This is a good reminder to people everywhere to put their trash in a garbage bins and not to litter.

Leadership students also worked on a survey on how much trash they produced each week at home and then figured how much trash they produced for the year. The results are staggering!!! For one year **8983 plastic bags** were used. The survey was only a small number of students in Maywood, so you can imagine if we totaled up the entire school use of plastic bags how much it would be.
